- **Mailing address (please include a street address for use by UPS or FedEx)**

Think of this as an "elevator pitch" – how you'd describe the project in 30 seconds

- **Table of Contents (conveying the organization of your book)**
- **Which existing books are similar to your own, and how will your book be innovative?**

If we are interested in your proposal, we will contact you to further discuss the project. Please note that due to the volume of submissions received, it may take up to 12 weeks to receive a response.

All submissions should be typed up using legible fonts, such as Times New Roman, Garamond, Arial, or similar. Please note that plagiarized material, as well as material produced by Artificial Intelligence (A.I.) is strictly prohibited and will not be accepted.

Editing your manuscript before its publication means reviewing and revising your written work, and correcting its grammar and style. Editing can also mean having others read through your work to help spot any potential mistakes before submitting it for consideration or publication.

Proofreading is vital, and something to consider before submitting your manuscript to Dark Moon Press for consideration. Readers will always notice your mistakes, and an error-filled manuscript just isn't professional.

We suggest using Microsoft Word, Spell Check, and Grammarly to review your book before submitting your pitch or sample chapters to us. We also recommend authors use a beta-reader, or a reader who reads and reviews the book before its publication. These steps are vital to ensure a high-quality submission and enjoyable final published product.

Once your manuscript has been accepted into the Dark Moon Press family, it will undergo further "light editing" by our team. This means working with the author to check for grammatical errors or punctuation flaws. We also work with authors to improve the overall structure, flow, and formatting of the book. After this process, we send authors a proofing copy in PDF format for final approval.

They also made a living as entertainers, fortune tellers, and grifters. Persecuted by the Nazis, and discriminated against to this day, the Rom have a long tradition of magic and shamanism. As Leland points out, these practices have parallels with those of other traditional pagan cultures around the world.

This book discusses spells, incantations and talismans used within Rom culture, as well as the more practical magic they use in their interaction with the Gorgios--the non-Gypsies. It is this latter topic which provides some of the most interesting and instructional reading. Leland gives some generalized methods of fortune-telling which any prospective psychic would do well to study; as well as the details of the 'Great Secret', a magic trick in which all of your money disappears.

This is one of the most in-depth and scholarly attempts to explain the phenomena of the Celtic belief in fairies. Based on Evans-Wentz' Oxford doctoral thesis, it includes an extensive survey of the literature from many different perspectives, including folklore, history, anthropology and psychology. The heart of the book is the ethnographic fieldwork conducted by Evans-Wentz, an invaluable snapshot of the fairy belief system taken just on the cusp of modernity. There are regional surveys of the fairy-faith in Ireland, Wales, Scotland, Brittany and the Isle of Man. Evans-Wentz later went on to become one of the leading authorities on Buddhism, and published many of the key documents of Tibetan Buddhism including the Tibetan *Book of the Dead*. Evans-Wentz examines each of the hypothetical explanations of the fairy phenomena. Among these are the theories that fairies were a reclusive race of dwarfs, that they are disembodied spirits, or that they are a figment of our imaginations. Evans-Wentz concludes that they may indeed be a manifestation of inhabitants of a higher reality that only some of us are able to view, let alone understand.



Donnelly considered Plato's account of Atlantis as largely factual and suggested that all known ancient civilizations were descended from this lost land through a process of hyper diffusionism. There once existed in the Atlantic Ocean, opposite the Mediterranean Sea, a large island, which was the remnant of an Atlantic continent, and known to the ancients as Atlantis, and that the description of this island given by Plato is not fable, as has been long supposed, but veritable history. That Atlantis was the region where man first rose from a state of barbarism to civilization.


Compiled by Aidan A. Kelly. The *Gardnerian Book of Shadows* is a classic volume of witchcraft and magick, though even today it can be tough to find a copy when you need one. This version of Gardner's personal Book of Shadows was originally posted on the internet in the mid-90s as part of the *Internet Book of Shadows* material.

This is the most comprehensive update of this text, along with commentary from Aidan A. Kelly. This tome could be considered one of the the most important central sacred texts of the Wiccan religion. However, it is important to point out that there is no 'official' Book of Shadows, and this simply describes Gardner's own copy. Typically, each coven has their own hand-written copy of a Book of Shadows, sometimes in cypher or code, which reflects its own practices and knowledge. This particular text is derived from a file posted on the internet in the early 90s, and quotes previously published material which was known to be in use by Gardner and his group.

The Book of Shadows was attributed by Gardner to an ancient, clandestine witch cult into which he claimed to have been initiated. However, modern researchers have concluded that it was composed by Gardner himself. The text shows influences from English and Celtic folklore, the Enochian system of John Dee, The Order of Thelema, the Golden Dawn, Stregaria, Freemasonry, Tantric Yoga,

the KJV Bible, and even Rudyard Kipling. This version organizes the material in chronological order and has estimated dates for each section, ranging from 1949 to 1961.

The copyright status of this text can best be described as 'Orphaned.' This version was compiled by Aidan A. Kelly. It was originally posted on the Internet in the mid-90s as part of the Internet

The text is informative in tone and does not stray to dogmatism; Conway instead provides sourced information in a factual, studied tone. For his part, Conway was not a believer in the lore of demons. Although he served variously as a Methodist, Unitarian and Freethought minister in life, he had little time for the

supernatural elements of Christianity. It is thus that *Demonology and Devil-lore* is an effort toward debunking and discounting what Conway viewed as the fantastical elements of a faith he otherwise identified with spiritually and morally. Today, *Demonology and Devil-lore* is somewhat archaic in terms of tone owing to its age. However, it still counts among the most thorough, in-depth and wide-ranging treatments of a subject which has fascinated religious and non-religious persons alike for centuries.





Enochian is a name often applied to an occult or angelic language recorded in the private journals of Dr. John Dee and his seer Edward Kelley in the late 16th century. 
Applying the term "Enochian" to the language is a modern convention - not found in Dee's journals. Dee referred to the language as "Angelical", the "Celestial Speech", the "Language of Angels", the "First Language of God-Christ" and the "Holy Language". He sometimes referred to its alphabet as "Adamical" because (according to Dee's Angels) it was used by Adam in Paradise to name all things. Dee also recorded that the Patriarch Enoch had been the last human (before Dee and Kelley) to know the language - thus prompting later scholars to refer to the language and Dee's entire magickal system as "Enochian".



divine entities that at one time were revered and worshiped. I can say one thing with absolute certainty, and that is that the old gods may be forgotten, but they are not gone. They are still here, patiently waiting somewhere in that realm that lies far beyond space and time. Waiting to be called upon once again.

The Malleus Maleficarum, The Hammer of Witches, Heinrich Kramer \$29.99



The Malleus Maleficarum (or *The Hammer of Witches*) was a terrifying historical text used for the supposed identification and persecution of those who were accused of witchcraft.

Historically, the author wrote the text following his failure to prosecute a number of women for witchcraft. It is a highly personal document, full of notes displaying the author's frustration at official complacency in the face of a spiritual threat, as well as being a practical guide for law officers who have to deal with a cunning, dangerous enemy.

This work, *Malleus Maleficarum* (or in English, *The Hammer of Witches*) was written by the German Catholic clergyman Heinrich Kramer (under his Latinized name Henricus Institor) and first published in the German city of Speyer in 1486.

Some describe it as the compendium of literature in demonology of the 15th century. This horrific book recommends the methods of both torture and deception to obtain confessions from those accused of witchcraft and heresy. Scholars estimate that approximately 110,000 witch trials were held in Europe between 1450 and 1750, with half of the trials ending with execution. Surprisingly, theologians of the Inquisition – a group

whose aim was to combat heresy against the Catholic Church and often use brutal methods to coerce confession – condemned the *Malleus* as unethical, while the Church condemned the text as false only three years after it first appeared. The book was condemned by top theologians of the Inquisition at the Faculty of Cologne for recommending illegal procedures, and for being inconsistent with Roman Catholic doctrines of demonology. However, Kramer received praise for his work by Pope Innocent VIII in the papal bull *Summis desiderantes affectibus*. Kramer was never removed and even enjoyed considerable prestige thereafter.

The *Malleus* calls sorcery akin to heresy, which was a crime at the time, and recommends that secular courts prosecute it as such. The *Malleus* suggested that torture was the only way to extract confessions, and death as the only certain way to end the "evils of witchcraft."

When it was published, heretics were often sentenced to be hanged or burned alive at the stake, and the *Malleus* suggested the same for "witches." Despite, or perhaps because of, being condemned by some members of the church, the *Malleus* was dreadfully popular in its time.

Extra-Sensory Perception, Joseph Banks Rhine \$19.99


The 1934 breakout study by parapsychologist Joseph Banks Rhine on the psychic phenomena as mental telepathy, precognition, and clairvoyance in a laboratory setting. In 1930, with psychologist William McDougall, he helped to establish the Parapsychology Laboratory at Duke University, Durham, North Carolina. There Rhine held some 90,000 experiments, using a wide variety of human subjects. Joseph Banks Rhine discusses his research work at Duke University. Extrasensory perception is the ability to acquire information shielded from the senses, and the book was “of such a scope and of such promise as to revolutionize psychical research and to make its title literally a household phrase.” Psychologist Carl Jung referred to Rhine’s work in 1963 in his Harper Collins Publishers book of *Memories, Dreams, Reflections*, as scientific proof that part of the psyche is not subject to the laws of space and time.



The Report on Unidentified Flying Objects, Edward J. Ruppelt \$29.99

The memoir of the US Air Force officer by Edward J. Ruppelt 1956 who coined the acronym UFO and spearheaded the early US Air Force UFO reports known as Project Blue Book. Ruppelt says in the Summer 1952, where an unnamed F-86 fighter pilot fires on an unidentified target was a UFO. The Report on Unidentified Flying Objects was noted for its suggestion that a few UFO sightings might be linked to spikes of atomic radiation as well as While the Air Force is officially dismissive of the spaceship theory, that conclusion is “far from unanimous” and staff within the Air Force had produced a UFO analysis, called the “Estimate of the Situation”, concluding that some UFOs were interplanetary spaceships. That analysis was rejected by a panel of scientists meeting in January 1953. Captain Ruppelt would later be vindicated as in September of 2025 that Group of military whistleblowers testify under oath they've seen UFOs and the government is part of a cover up. Military veterans and whistleblowers told how they have suffered in their careers for speaking out about unidentified aerial phenomena, GOP congresswoman Anna Paulina Luna, who chairs the House Oversight and Government Reform's Task Force on the Declassification of Federal Secrets, chaired a panel Tuesday on unidentified aerial phenomena (UAPs), another name for UFOs Air Force veterans Jeffrey Nuccetelli and Dylan Borland, as well as Navy veteran Alexandro Wiggins, spoke at the hearing, along with journalist George Knapp, a prominent figure in the UFO disclosure community. . – from the



Evidence soon prompted Nick's return to the house. Nick and Katrina later returned for a Halloween special at the house featured on TLC.





***Frankenstein The Modern Prometheus*, Mary Wollstonecraft Shelley \$19.99**





***The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, Robert Louis Stevenson \$15.99**



The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde by Robert Louis Stevenson is a novella written during the late 19th century that delves into the duality of human nature and the struggle between good and evil. The narrative follows Mr. Utterson, a lawyer, as he investigates the mysterious relationship between his friend, Dr. Jekyll, and the sinister Mr. Hyde, uncovering dark secrets that test the boundaries of morality. The Fall of the House of Usher, Edgar Allan Poe \$9.99

A 1839 classic is a short story by American writer Edgar Allan Poe, first published in 1839 in Burton's Gentleman's Magazine, then included in the collection Tales of the Grotesque and Arabesque in 1840. The short story, a work of Gothic fiction, includes themes of madness, family, isolation, and metaphysical identities. As with most of Poe's work, the story contains multiple layers of meaning and symbolism.

The story concerns the narrator's visit to a strange mansion owned by his childhood friend, who is behaving increasingly oddly as he and his twin sister dwell within the 'melancholy' atmosphere of the house. The story is narrated by a childhood friend of Roderick Usher, the owner of the Usher mansion. This friend is riding to the house, having been summoned by Roderick Usher, having complained in his letter that he is suffering from some illness and expressing a hope that seeing his old friend will lift his spirits.

When he arrives, the narrator finds a gloomy and vaguely menacing atmosphere, and his friend, Usher, is much changed since he last saw him: overly sensitive to every sound and sight, and prone to dramatic mood swings. Meanwhile, Roderick's twin

sister Madeline is afflicted with a disease which, Roderick tells the narrator, means she will soon die. These twins are the last in the family line, the last descendants of the 'house of Usher'.

Roderick Usher is a gifted poet and artist, whose talents the narrator praises before sharing a poem Usher wrote, titled 'The Haunted Palace'. The ballad concerns a royal palace which was once filled with joy and song, until 'evil things' attacked the king's palace and made it a desolate shadow of what it once was.


Several days later, Roderick tells the narrator that Madeline has died, and they lay her to rest in a vault. In the days that follow, the narrator starts to feel more uneasy in the house, and attributes his nervousness to the gloomy furniture in the room where he sleeps. The narrator begins to suspect that Roderick is harbouring some dark secret.


Roderick grows more erratic in his behaviour, and the narrator reads to his friend to try to soothe him. The plot of the romance (a fictional title invented by Poe himself, called 'Mad Trist') concerns a hero named Ethelred who enters the house of a hermit and slays a dragon.

In a shocking development, Madeline breaks out of her coffin and enters the room, and Roderick confesses that he buried her alive. Madeline attacks her brother and kills both him and herself in the struggle, and the narrator flees the house. It is a stormy night, and as he leaves he sees the house fall down, collapsing into the lake which reflects the house's image.






Varney Varney the Vampire or, the Feast of Blood James Malcolm Rymer was a series of penny dreadfuls is a Victorian era serialized gothic horror story variously attributed to James Malcolm Rymer and Thomas Peckett Prest. It first appeared in 1845-1847 as a series of weekly cheap pamphlets. The author was paid by the typeset line so when the story was published in book form in 1847, it was of epic length: the original edition ran to 876 double-columned pages and 232 chapters. It is the tale of the vampire Sir Francis Varney, and introduced many of the tropes present in vampire fiction recognizable to modern audiences. It was the first story to refer to sharpened teeth for a vampire, noting "With a plunge he seizes her neck in his fang-like teeth." The story has a confused setting. While ostensibly set in the early eighteenth century, there are references to the Napoleonic Wars and other indicators that the story is contemporary to the time of its writing in the mid-nineteenth century. Varney's adventures also occur in various locations including London, Bath, Winchester, Naples and Venice. The titular character is considered to be the first sympathetic vampire in fiction.



The Vampyre; a Tale, by John William Polidori \$9.99

The Vampyre; a Tale by John William Polidori is a gothic novella written in the early 19th century, during the Romantic period. The story introduces readers to the themes of vampirism and seduction within the context of high society, exploring the implications of darker human desires. It is one of the earliest works of fiction to feature a vampire as the central character, paving the way for subsequent literature in the genre. 
The Invisible Man, H.G. Wells \$19.99



The Invisible Man is an 1897 science fiction novel by H. G. Wells. Originally serialized in *Pearson's Weekly* in 1897, it was published as a novel the same year. *The Invisible Man* to whom the title refers is Griffin, a scientist who has devoted himself to research into optics and invents a way to change a body's refractive index to that of air so that it neither absorbs nor reflects light. He carries out this procedure on himself and renders himself invisible, but fails in his attempt to reverse it. A practitioner of random and irresponsible violence, Griffin has become an iconic character in horror fiction.

While its predecessors, *The Time Machine* and *The Island of Doctor Moreau*, were written using first-person narrators, Wells adopts a third-person objective point of view in *The Invisible Man*.


The War of the Worlds, H.G. Wells \$19.99




The Kind Memory's Children, Clay Gilbert \$16.99

Aiden Kincaid and Avery Meadows meet on the first day of their freshman year at Oxford College in Georgia, in the fall of 1991. They bond over their loneliness and their common love of a rock band called Coventina's Well, a legendary holdout from the counterculture of the 1960s. The day they meet each other, they also meet a strange, sweet girl with the unlikely name of Lucifer Button. 



The Memoirs of a Dark God, Damien Christopher \$19.99


